By using an computer refurbished by OPEQ, you are participating to our mission which is to encourage social integration, reemployment and ecoresponsible recycling.


For 20 years, OPEQ has given a second life to more than 250 000 computers and more than 70 000 hours of paid internships every year to young people in Quebec.




## Section 2 – Windows 10 registration




1. Select the “Canada” region.
2. Click on “Yes”.



3. Choose the keyboard layout “Canadian Multilingual Standard”.
4. Click on “Yes”.




5. Click on “Skip ».



If your computer has a wireless card, make sure you have screwed the antennas according to the *Connection Guide*, then follow the steps below.


Otherwise, skip to step 10.

6. Check the name of your network before making your choice and have the password ready (often given by your Internet provider or written on your router).
7. Select your network's name.
8. Enter your password in the text field.
9. Click on “Next”.




10. The computer automatically checks for updates. Wait for them to be completed. This may take several minutes.

**IMPORTANT:** Do not interrupt the search.




11. Read the Microsoft license agreement.
12. Click on "Accept" to continue.




13. Select "Set up for personal use".

14. Click on "Next".




15. Click on "Offline Account".


We strongly suggest that you create a local account. You can always reconfigure your computer later, no choice is permanent.



16. Click on "Limited Experience".




17. Enter your name in the text field.

19. If you want to protect your user account with a password, enter it in the text field. Otherwise, leave the field blank and press "Next".


It's important to remember your password, because if you forget it, you will no longer be able to use your computer without the help of a technician.

You can click on the eye to the right of the text field to see your password.




20. If you choose to use a password, you must enter it again in the text field.


21. Click on "Next".




22. If you have entered a password, select a first security question.

24. Click on "Next".




25. Select a second security question.





26. Enter the answer to the second security question.

28. Select a third security question.




29. Enter the answer to the third security question.  
30. Click on "Next".







